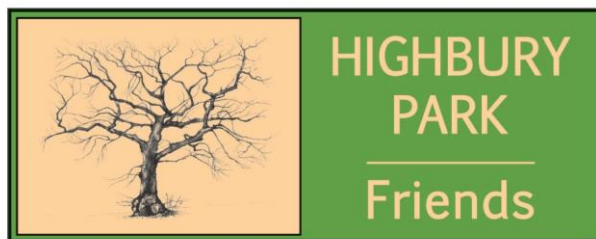


Events Programme 2024
